Training and Reaching Youth - USA



Brian Harmon and his co-worker, Mike Wilson, are being used of the Lord in the great state of Michigan. Brian reports how forty-one students in the public junior and senior high-school system responded to the Gospel after many months of sharing Christ in the student-led Bible study classes in these locations. They have enjoyed seeing this harvest and praise the Lord as they trust God to open doors for similar ministry in additional schools in the area. Not long ago, three students from the LGBTQ community approached Brian with questions about how God views them. With love, Brian was

able to share with them how God knows what is right and best for us and the need for us to respond to His perfect plan for our lives. God does not discriminate; we all need to be born again. Jesus is in the business of making us whole again, as we are all broken. These students responded by telling Brian, "We've never been able to have a conversation like this with a Christian. Thank you." They came for a whole school year to the Bible classes and are now faced with the decision to submit to God or not, the same decision we all face ever since the encounter Adam and Evan had with Satan in the Garden of Eden.



Training and Reaching Youth - Russia



Our open-air ministry outreach in Russia under the direction of Mikhael Tsvirinko (we call him Misha) is a great blessing. Misha is able to preach about Christ in public schools, boarding schools, shelters, military bases, at homes and on the streets. He is also able to train youth leaders and Sunday School teachers in the methods we use. The Christians there have a keen interest to present the Gospel, and they have not stopped proclaiming Christ, even when it is not convenient. Misha and his co-workers are visited at times by some of our other evangelists who travel to Russia and minister alongside of them. They also take advantage of special opportunities to present the

Good News, such as sporting events and youth conferences. Just recently, a large youth conference was organized in the city of Maykop, just a few hours drive from Misha's town. About 600 young men from various locations assembled here, and Misha had the opportunity to be involved with them using the sketchboard and different object lessons. Misha's co-worker, Andrey Smirnyagin, made several mission trips to such places as Armenia, Tajikistan and the Republic of Georgia where he shared the Gospel with different groups of people, many of the Muslims and worked with local churches reaching out to their communities.
