Evangelism brings the "Gospel of Peace" to the seekers of God's peace. Tyshawna is an 18-year-old whom I met in downtown Dallas while ministering with Rick Moore. She started tearing up and coming under conviction while going over the commandments. She wanted to know how she could be sure that she was hearing God's voice. I had her read John 3:16 out loud. I told her she had just heard words from God. I encouraged her to continue to seek Him in the Bible. While at Blackhawk College in Moline, Illinois, with staff evangelist Steve Johnson, a student who was troubled by the gospel message asked me to talk with him. He said he knew a lot of the Bible but had no peace. I showed him scripture verses, and Brian finally stopped me and said he wanted to pray to God while I listened. Sounded like a sinner's prayer to me! Simone, a student at Boston University, told me she grew up in church but was not clear on the Bible's message. She thought she needed to do better for God to accept her. We went over Bible verses that dealt with God's justice and that only the sacrifice of the perfect Lamb, Jesus Christ, was able to satisfy His justice and provide her mercy. She had to leave but was grateful for the conversation. Theo is a student at the University of Cincinnati. He met our team last year and told me that being at peace with yourself can be achieved in many different ways. I told him only God is the true provider of peace. He stayed and was very attentive to what the Bible had to say. This fall, I was able to witness to students from Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Thailand, Tanzania, China, UAE, Lebanon, India, Nepal, Ethiopia, Morocco, Benin, South Africa, Nigeria, Bangladesh, Haiti, and Pakistan.

The following is a testimony from a Liberty University student after spending a week in Miami and Boston with us. "Miami and Boston will forever have my heart. They were tough (especially Boston), but they were amazing. I learned so much through you and the other leaders. I learned so much about Christ and His love for us. I learned about how precious His people are and you definitely challenged me to continue to fulfill the Great Commission."
