Dear Brothers & Sisters,

Thank you for your prayers, your encouragement and support as we press on in the work to which God has called us. Although we are living in a season of life full of uncertainty and chaos, Diane and I are so excited, for we have not seen people so willing and open to the Gospel since 911 when the terrorist attack took place in the United States.

We are teaming up with Faith Community Bible Church here in Loudon New Hampshire for the next few months. We have been going to Hampton Beach on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays nights and Weirs Beach on Friday night. We have had the opportunity to share the Gospel with people from all over the world including Egypt, Columbia, Canada, and other countries. The Lord has given us many opportunities to share with people of different religions and ways of life including those who are atheist, Hindu, Muslim, evolutionist, and practicing homosexuals.

I would like to share this testimony of a young lady who said she was gay and happy because God allowed her to be gay. In the beginning of our conversation, she was very hostile. She said she hated men. She asked me what I thought about gay people. I then asked her if it really matters what I think or does it matter what God thinks about homosexuality. I asked her why did God create male and female? Her response was that she didn't know. Then I took her to Genesis 2 and shared how God had created man and placed him in the garden to take care of it. I shared how God said it is not good for man to be alone so He created a suitable helper. I asked her why didn't God create for Adam another man instead of a woman to be his suitable helper? She said, "Good question." So then I asked her why she thought God created man AND woman? She said, "Another good question, who knows?" I took her to Genesis 1:26-28 and explained that women have a very special role in God's creation. God blessed male and female and told them to be fruitful and multiply. She then said, "Well, I can adopt a child." I told her that would be wonderful, but is that being fruitful according to God's plan? I could tell by the countenance on her face that she understood. We had a 10 to 15-minute conversation in which I shared the Gospel. She was willing to take the Gospel of John and promised to read it. She thanked me and asked if she could get my phone number. I told her I don't give out my number, but gave her my email and asked her if she would let me know what she thought about the Gospel of John. Then I asked her if I could pray for her. She said, "I would love that." God was truly at work as the mind of this young, hostile homosexual person opened up to the truth of God's Word. Let's pray for this young lady that she will allow the Word of God which I shared with her to set her free from the bondage of sin (John 8:32). Her name is Shania.

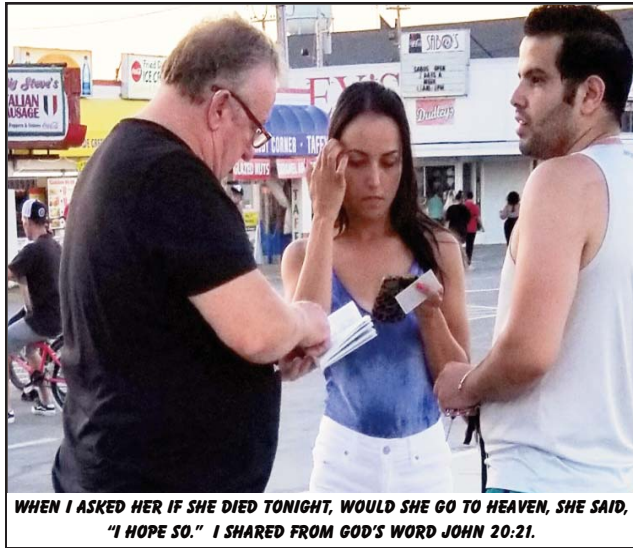
- * Praise for hearts that have been stirred to seek Him.

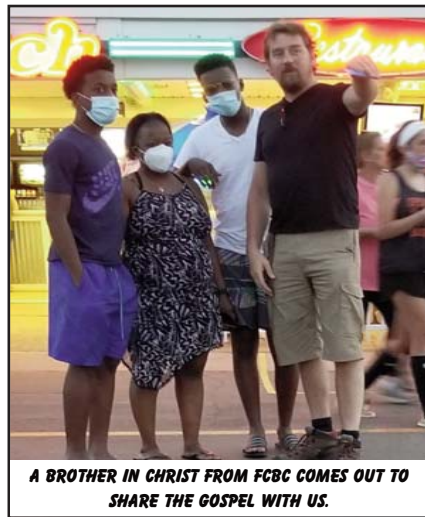

WE HAD MANY ONE-ON-ONE CONVERSATIONS AT HAMPTON BEACH.



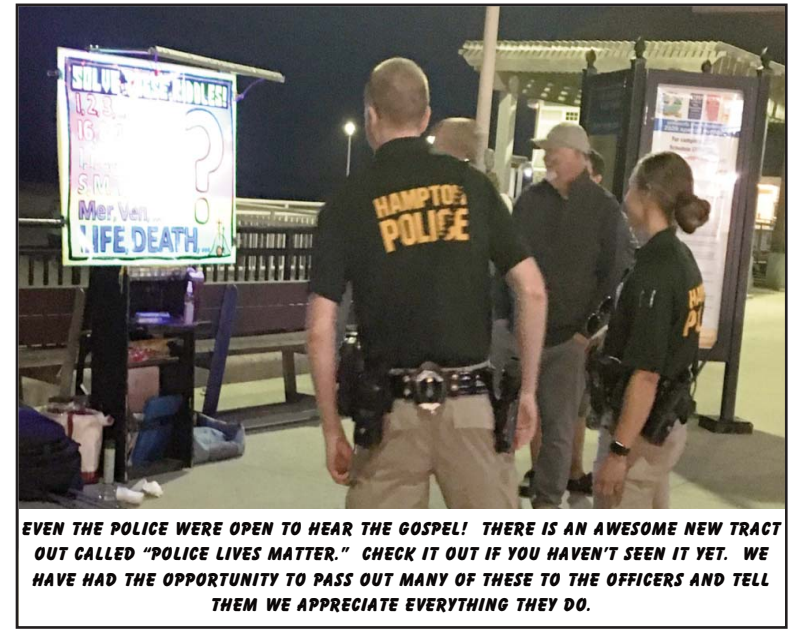
GOD HAS GIVEN US MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE THE GOSPEL.

GOD HAS GIVEN US SO MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE THE GOSPEL THESE LAST FEW MONTHS.



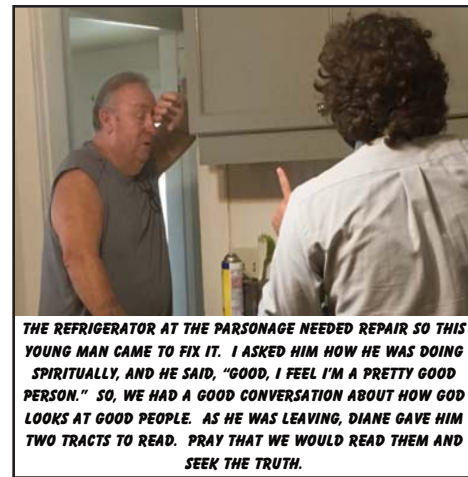

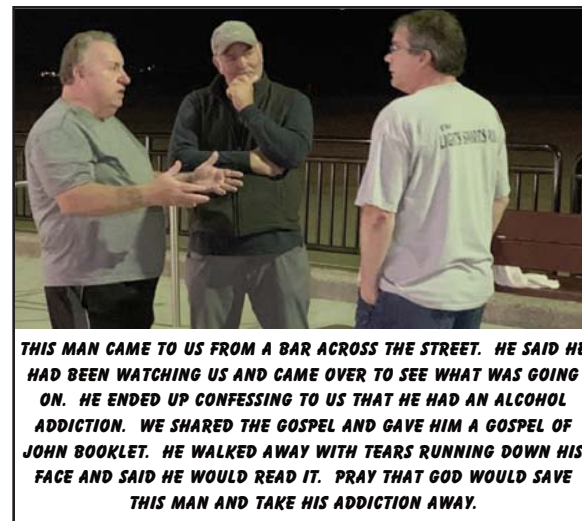
THESE MIGRANT WORKERS ARE SO APPRECIATIVE.
