Teaching the class about forgiveness and the 12 disciples is **Brian**, who is one of the main teachers in the club.

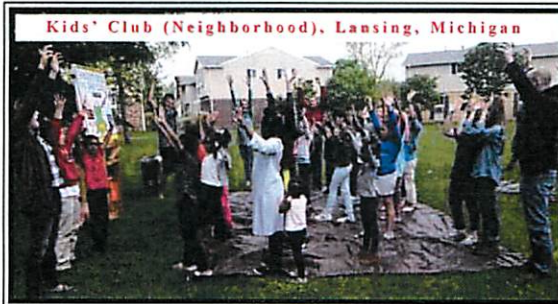

"Second Area" Public high school ministry has always been a highlight and encouragement to me. This year there have been tremendous questions and wonderful involvement from the students. We're seeing bridges made from school to the local churches that are involved. We are experiencing favor with the staff and administration(s). What an open door! Another huge encouragement and prayer need is: there are seven additional schools that have contacted me to start Bible clubs. We are currently in five different schools

each week. We meet inside the schools during the lunch hour(s). There are multiple lunch hours in each school, so this totals 10 clubs each week. We need more laborers. **Pray for me** as I consider how to train and maybe offer an apprenticeship program to equip others to do the same.

"Third Area" College ministry has been unique this year. We have seen an increased interest and participation in outreach from believers on campus. Each college has Christian students and/or campus ministers who join us when we go out. This is truly a huge blessing! From the lost, we've noticed a sensitivity to the things of the Lord and an increased level of concern about their own souls. We focused on 3 colleges each week (Tuesday – WMU, Wednesday – MSU, Thursday – CMU). We go to campus in the afternoon, after the high school lunch programs.
