Reaching The Community

OUT IN THE STATE OF WYOMING, our OAC man, Kurt Schafli, conducts a variety of Gospel outreach ministries. One particular day, he was at a park where some young folks were playing basketball. Once the game was over, the kids sat down and watched as Kurt presented a clear gospel sketchboard message. One of the oldest boys helped read Bible passages, and at the end of the meeting, everyone was given a Bible. Additional literature was also available for those who already owned a Bible. What a blessing it is to reach non-churched young people out in the communities and neighborhoods in this way where our OAC staff minister on a regular basis. Some of these kids have never had the Gospel



explained to them before. Kurt also has opportunity to minister in group homes where young people in his area who get into trouble are sent. He also conducts Bible Camp and other organized types of meetings geared toward evangelism and discipleship.

How Can I Be Sure?

OUR OAC MAN IN ECUADOR, David Proano, shared that they were presenting a drama and preaching the Gospel and were able to talk with a young man at the end of one presentation. As David shared about the Bible and its trustworthiness, the young man asked, "How can I be sure that what you said is the truth? There are many religions like the Jehovah Witnesses, Mormons, Catholics, etc...Which of those are correct?" David answered him saying, "Ask God. If He has been talking to you today, He will show you what He wants for you...." Like Elijah said: "...the God who answers by fire, He is God." Then, David gave the young man a copy of the Gospel of John,



his telephone number and the address for their church. He seemed to be very interested. David believes that as an evangelist, he is not called to force people to believe. Instead, we give to the people our reasons for what we believe, but our hope is that while we proclaim the true Gospel, the Holy Spirit will use the words to convince of sin, righteousness and judgment. Our task is to present the Gospel in the most biblical and clear way possible and be available to help the people connect with the Lord. Jesus said: "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. I and My Father are one."
