Do you have a burden for souls?

America is a nation where millions of people attend church every week. And yet we know that there are millions more who will not or cannot attend, many of whom may go their whole lives without ever hearing a clear presentation of the gospel. We have many strong churches, but what about those who will never see the inside of a church? Who will go and reach out to them?

Want to get equipped?

We at Open Air Campaigners are presenting this exciting one-week Sketchboard Evangelism Training (SET) in June. All participants will be trained in many aspects of open air work. Students will have the opportunity to learn adult presentations and children's presentations during the training. All students will be tutored according to their level of experience. Those who attend the SET will be equipped to go back to their home church or field of ministry and conduct fruitful, open-air outreaches.

Who is the Target Audience for SET?

SET is intended for all Christian workers, lay people and students over the age of 18 who are interested in learning principles, techniques and practical tools for effective, open-air evangelism.

What are the Dates and Location?

The SET will be held at Boston from Monday, June 3 through Saturday, June 8, 2019 and again in Baltimore-DC from Monday, June 10 through Saturday June 15, 2019.

What do the Fees include?

The fees include cost of instruction, all training, and materials, travel to and from field meetings, meals (which begin with breakfast on Monday) as well as overnight accommodations through Friday night. Payment in full OR a nonrefundable registration fee must accompany the registration. Any balance due may be paid upon arrival at the SET.

What is the Refund Policy?

Cancellations must be received no later than May 31st. OAC reserves the right to close or cancel the training because of maximum or insufficient enrollment or any unforeseen circumstances.





What are the Objectives of SET?

At the conclusion of SET, participants will have received not only the training but practical application and experience in order to:

- Present the gospel of Christ in a direct, positive and challenging manner.
- Prepare evangelistic Bible stories for children and adults with illustrations painted on a sketch board.
- Discern proper techniques, including location and timing for conducting outdoor meetings.
- Learn how to communicate the Gospel one-on-one with adults and children.
- Sense a personal fulfillment of Ephesians 4:12
