

Please pray for Nawras, a Syrian Muslim who was a joy to speak with (pictured on the left). I got a chance to share the Gospel of everlasting life with him and encouraged him to repent and believe in Jesus.

I also shared my love of the history of his country as recorded in the Syrian Chronicle, a very ancient text. He asked if I had ever read the Koran, and I responded that I had read a little of it and I remembered a part that said true prophets don't lie and that Jesus was a true prophet. Nawras agreed that Jesus was a true prophet and that Muslims respect him as such.

I told him: "Jesus said, 'I am the way the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but through me." That means Jesus was telling the truth when He said He is the only way to Heaven... and your Koran says you should believe Him. The Koran also says to listen to the people of the Book, and that's me... so please give some serious thought to these things." Chip was able to get a copy of the Gospel of John into Nawras' hands and he said he would read it.

Please pray that Nawras would encounter Christ and be saved as he reads the word of God.



Have I mentioned how much I love Hampton Beach evangelism? It seems the places where people go to walk around and hang out are becoming rarer these days. But they provide such an excellent public forum for the gospel. One summer night we had tons of people stop by the sketch board to try and solve a riddle; and we had many volunteers engage them in conversation. It's so wonderful seeing the body of Christ exercise their faith by learning to dialogue with people who don't believe as we do. Jesus called it being salt and light. Every one of us have circles of influence and God-given Divine opportunities to shine the light of the gospel into peoples' lives. What I have found is that street evangelism is an easy and effective way to practice for those moments. People have questions about God, and it's super fun when God uses you to answer some of those questions. Let us know if you want to come out with us.

Mark and Bailey had some very good questions, as well as some "stump the Christian" questions, but seemed genuinely interested in getting answers. This is not always the case, as some people simply thrive on creating strife and trying to produce doubt in believing Christians. But they didn't come across that way. I shared the Gospel with them and spent over an hour chatting, answering, and asking questions. Pray for Mark and Bailey, that the Word sown in their hearts will produce a harvest of repentance and faith unto salvation.

My goal as a street evangelist is different than some. I consider it a "win" if I can help people understand why Jesus died on the cross and why it applies to them today. My goal is not to get them to repeat some magic incantation; but to share God's word and let it produce faith in their hearts unto salvation. Salvation is of the Lord, and I am not the Holy Spirit. God's word is powerful. We sow the word into the hearts of people and let the Lord water it. It's quite amazing when, every once in a while, we get a glimpse behind the curtain to see how that works...

We had a good conversation about Darwin's doubts in his own theory and how he admitted that the complexity of the human eye alone was enough to unravel it. These days we understand that there is no such thing as a "simple cell," though some schools keep teaching this outdated nonsense. The amazing design and complexity we see around us is a daily witness to the fact that we have a Creator. I gave Travis a copy of "The Atheist Delusion" by Ray Comfort. 
Please pray for us! We need the Lord's favor as we share His rescue plan with a lost, hopeless, and sometimes hostile world.
