Deidra and I used to sing this song in Bible college. It has recently become very real to us. In the early fall, Deidra was diagnosed with Lymes Disease, which left her with Bell's Palsy on the right side of her face. A short time later, she had major surgery to remove a mass on her colon. The pathology report said that the mass was cancerous, and that it had spread into her lymph nodes and surrounding areas. It is an "angry" advanced cancer at level three. Lord willing, she will begin Chemotherapy in the very near future. This treatment should last about six months.

I will be taking a medical furlough from OAC for at least six months, after which time, our situation will be evaluated. I will then either extend the furlough for a maximum of another six months, return to my senior evangelist duties, or retire.

I will try to update you as best as I can.
