Our Bible Club at East Rochester Elementary started with a tiny group of kids, with one second-grader, Jayden, worried that he would be the only boy. And then, one day, a friend of Jayden's threw a paper airplane into the meeting, with the



question: "Is it too late to sign up for Bible Club?" We now have 12-

13 children that attend regularly, including 6-7 boys. We are currently studying the ministry years of Jesus, leading up to His resurrection.

The children at the Edgerton Community Center Bible Club are going through the Creation series. They regularly pepper me with questions: "How can I talk to God?"; "We will die and come back and die and come back and always get a second chance, right?"; "Why does God hate gay people?" (their exact words); "Where is Adam now?" The average age of the group is 8, and the spiritual warfare to reach them is intense.
