Shoshanah did just that, and even after having been promoted to eternity, folks still tell me how she had impacted their lives. PTL! Since we have an 'itinerant' ministry, it makes sense that I was able to present a short memorial powerpoint in 3 different congregations. (Pavillion, Riverton & Casper). For our immediate family and friends, a memorial service is planned for August 13 in Pavillion, followed by a meal and a visit to Mountain View Cemetery. It will be done according to Shoshanah's wishes. It is the first chance for our children from the East Coast to participate. In April, I joined Allen a couple of times for the Sho-Rap Bible study that we had started many years ago. It thrilled my heart to see how GOD has called Allen and Miriam to continue these ministries, also at the Center of Hope and for the homeless. For summer they plan VBS events in the housing areas, just like we used to do. Both tribes have given their permission for which we give GOD the praise! As much as I can, I plan to be involved, but first I will have to get through 5 weeks of radiation that started on April 25<sup>th</sup>.

I trust that GOD will give me the strength to continue the weekly Shabbat Bible studies and special YHVH-FEAST events. In the picture the Passover celebration, April 15, focusing on the parallels between GOD'S Pesach Lamb, Yeshua, and the official Pesach lamb of the High-Priest. (1 Cor. 5:7-8) Yeshua fulfilled every detail by the day (*being chosen on Aviv 14, then inspected for 4 days, and resurrected on the Day of First-Fruit! 1 Cor 15:20*) and by the hour. (Ask for the list!) One new participant was surprised and excited that such an event was offered in Fremont County, WY. She promptly joined us for the Shabbat Bible study the next day and since. On that occasion I even have the joy to offer a fellowship meal.
