What did Jesus do? He went to the next town, Capernaum, and taught multiple Sabbaths in their synagogue.

You who pray and give and read our letters there is a Day approaching. Be active in your church and active in sharing the Gospel. Consider bringing a mission team to Boston or having us come alongside your church "to equip the saints for the work of ministry".
