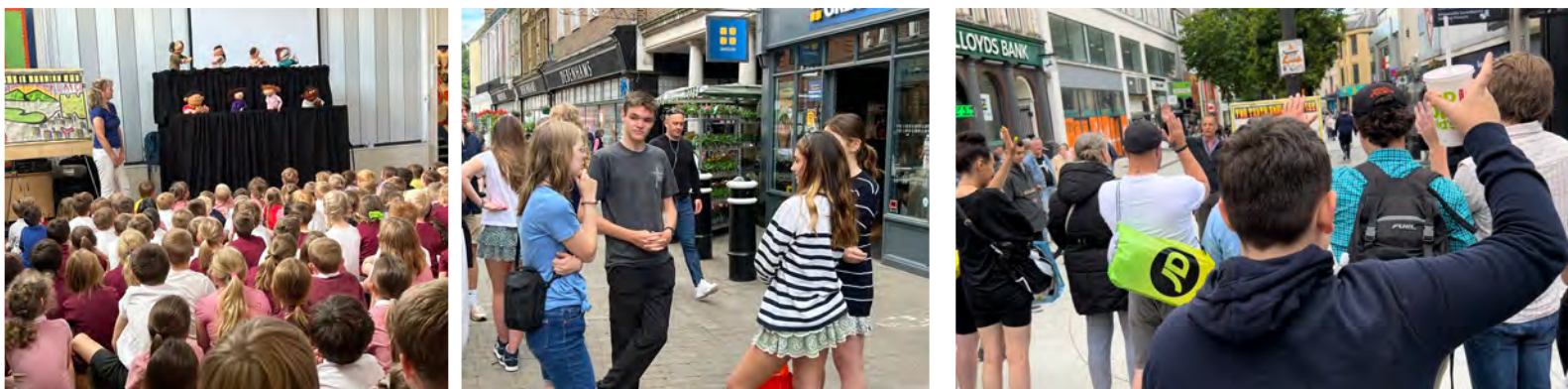

Thanks for your faithful support and prayers. We thank God for you and your partnership with us in the Gospel!

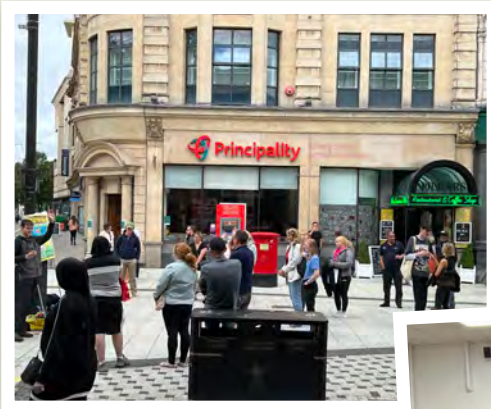
Our ministry here in England had a great kick start with a youth mission team from Grace Bible Church, Richmond. We commenced street outreaches in the towns and cities of Andover, Newbury, Salisbury, Winchester, even London, and conducted after school kids' programs and had the unique opportunity to do some public school assemblies. The school kids loved the programs and were engaged in the puppet show and Gospel message. They just lapped up every word, and because of the nearby military base, we were even able to reach kids from Nepal and Lebanon, amongst other countries with the Gospel.

There are over 200 Jehovah Witnesses in the town of Andover, and we have had a lot of encounters with them. Week by week we get to talk to them about the Gospel. After a long conversation with me on Saturday, she was invited to come to church, and she came Sunday morning and then, again, Sunday evening.
