Dear Praying Partners,

**Jesus has just had a conversation** with a Samaritan woman exposing her sin and inability to worship God. She knows Messiah is coming, and Jesus tells her you are looking at Him. This is the Gospel, good news for sinners; Jesus is the only acceptable sacrifice for our sins. Those who truly believe will want to tell others like this Samaritan woman is doing in John 4. Pray that the people you read about in our letter will become like this Samaritan woman, telling others about Jesus being the Savior.

**On November 3rd**, David approached me at Boston University. We had talked last April, and being raised as an orthodox Jew had never read the New Testament. I had given him a Bible and told him to read Matthew. David told me he read Matthew and was so intrigued he read Mark, Luke, and John and was now asking me what to read next. He then said, "Will I go to hell for not believing Jesus is the Messiah? I told him he would go to hell for being an unforgiven sinner. He left for class but not before taking my phone number.

**Rosilain is a student** at Roxbury Community College. She was well-versed in biology and science and told me in late October that they had the answers to life's problems. She finally agreed that there must be an all-powerful and all-knowing creator. Three weeks later, we met again and had another long conversation. She finally agreed scientists can make mistakes, and she took the Gospel of John.

**Srishti is a student** at Northern Kentucky University. During our week of evangelism with God's Bible School and College in Cincinnati in late September, we traveled to NKU with a dozen students. Bethany, a student on our team, approached Srishti, who was working on an assignment on a table nearby. After introducing herself and having some initial conversation, she asked Srishti if she considered herself a good person. After going over the ten commandments and the reality of heaven and hell, Bethany asked her what she deserved. "Based on the commandments, I guess I deserve hell." Bethany asked if that concerned her and if she ever thought about life after death. Srishti told her that at that very moment, she was working on a paper for her psychology class on "what comes after death?" Both girls exchanged phone numbers. Two texts over the next two weeks were not answered, so I told Bethany to pray for two weeks. In late October, the two girls met again. Bethany emailed me and said Srishti is extremely excited to continue to meet and learn more about God and becoming a Christian.

**Diane and I** cannot thank you enough for your faithful praying and giving. Every day we go out, our staff and team members get into conversations like the ones you have just read about. Please continue to be vigilant in prayer for us. May God bless your Christmas celebration of Him.
