We've been busy and have had some very good ministry this summer and fall. We have recently started to slow down some due to the colder, wet weather and a little sickness in the Moore household. In the early summer, we went to assist the OAC Boston Branch as they hosted a team from New York, holding adult and kids' ministry around the area; the students on the team got plenty of experience.

The rest of our summer and fall was spent at our numerous regular ministry locations around the Dallas-Ft. Worth Metroplex. Two abbreviated trainings were held in the fall, one for about 18 members of our home church, several of which participated with us at our town's local festival. At the festival, we had conversations with over 200 + people and handed out about 750 gospel tracts and 150 Gospels of John. We also trained members of Believers Bible Church in Carrollton. They are a congregation of mostly Indian believers, and 13 adults and a few older teens participated. We look forward to assisting them with their VBS in June 2023!

In October, Rick attended the OAC Directors Conference held at a campground in Pennsylvania. It was a time of refreshment, encouragement, fellowship, prayer, training, and new ideas for ministry. We also had a great Halloween outreach in Terrell working with a team from Chisholm Baptist Church, reaching people with sketchboard presentations, thousands of gospel tracts, personal conversations and 1,100 Bibles provided by the Gideons. It's a great outreach to their community each year.

Lastly, in December we had a team of eight who helped us distribute over 6,000 gospel tracts at the Dallas Christmas parade. We heard many say thank you and saw a bunch of excited kids and adults with smiling faces!

As Christmas and the new year approaches, we are reminded of how thankful we are for your prayers and support this last year. Every tract, every booklet, our painting supplies, and everything else we use in ministry is dependent on you and your generosity, as the Lord leads all of you. We are humbly grateful for your partnership and some of you even volunteer to "hit the streets" with us, and that is such an encouragement and blessing to us. **THANK YOU!**
