Health: So that you can pray intelligently I copy the doctor's comments on the upper and lower scopes (11/7) and the follow up CT scan (11/23): "Dr Shear saw erosive abrasions in your stomach linked to reactive severe gastritis. Random colon biopsies were negative for any tissue changes.

The rectal biopsies showed radiation proctitis and ulcers. One precancerous colon polyp was removed. The CT of the abdomen (small intestines) was done to look for obvious changes of mesenteric ischemia, luminal disease like diverticulitis, or potential obstruction, since your weight loss is abnormal. Result: Inguinal hernia." I can feel the bulge and there is a constant dull pain and occasional bloating. The bleeding stopped, for which I am grateful; also, that no additional cancer has been diagnosed. Praise God and keep praying for complete healing, if not, surgery might be necessary! Thank you!

**Holiday Season:** According to Scripture, in winter (December) the conception of the Messiah took place. During his ministry year Yeshua visited Jerusalem during *Chanukkah*, even though this was not one of the mandatory pilgrim festivals. We read in John 10:22-23: "The *Festival of Dedication* took place in Jerusalem. It was winter, and Jesus was walking in the Temple in Solomon's portico."
