I often work in Kensington with Tony Rizzo and Sam Frey. Tony runs a youth ministry called Safety Zone, and I am happy to help him with this ministry four or five times a year. I also have the opportunity to minister in a park located in Delaware. There are many young people enslaved to Fentanyl in the Kensington area. Daily, they sit on the sidewalk in filth and garbage with open sores and abscesses all over their bodies. Most have little concern for their health and future. Their only fear is going into withdrawal. Please pray for them as we reach out with the hope of the Gospel.

I've been in this ministry for 43 years and have seen many cultural changes. We are truly living in the end times according to Romans 1:25-27. The world has literally lost its moral compass. What used to be right is now wrong; good is now evil, and loving your neighbor as long as they do not offend you is common thinking. In other words, you are your own god. We used to have good crowds at our open-air meetings, but now only a few people stop to listen. However, there are still a few, and God cares for them all. The biblical teaching that straight is the gate and narrow is the way that

leads to life, and few there be that find it is certainly true, especially these days. God keeps reminding me that this world is not my home; I'm just passing through, thank God. I will keep preaching the Gospel just as long as God gives me breath because that's my job and my purpose in life. I preach three days a week in Camden with four other men.
