## **Reaching North Central Idaho & Eastern Washington with the Gospel of Jesus Christ**

One more year is coming to a close. Wow! They seem to go by faster every year. 2023 has certainly been a full year. As always, we strive to make the best use of time for the cause of Christ. Here's a brief overview of where lives were impacted by the Gospel of Christ.

## College Campus

January – May and early fall were spent on the campuses of North Idaho College (NIC), Washington State University (WSU), University of Idaho (UI), and Lewis Clark State College (LCSC). I continue to be an advisor to Campus Alive in Christ, an on-campus club at NIC. WSU and UI are always great outreaches as the size of the campuses provide many opportunities to share the Gospel with a wide variety of students. I am especially encouraged with the development of ministry at LCSC. Relationships with students and even a couple of the faculty have begun to grow and so I am concentrating my efforts here.

## **Community Events**

Because almost all of the neighboring towns have some sort of an annual event, summer was packed with community outreaches. When those happen, I get to work with local churches and engage the public using my sketch board to present the gospel. For some of these events, I take Jesse, Angela's mule, which is always great for ministry! I have yet to have anyone turn down a Gospel tract when I'm on a mule and Jesse makes a good conversation starter. We did outreach this year in Whitebird, Culdesac, Craigmont, Kamiah, Kooskia, Grangeville, Stites, and Winchester. We are hoping to add a few more to the list in 2024.

## Kids

In the spring I got to work with Winchester Community Church conducting an after-school Kids Bible Club. The school bus stop is across the street from the church so when the kids got off the bus, they could come right over to the church for Bible Club. This made for a great opportunity for the Gospel, and to serve the local community. Bailey joined us a few times to help and it was great fun to work alongside my daughter.

I had the privilege to serve as chapel speaker at Cocolalla Lake Bible Camp for 200+ campers (11-12 years-old) and staff in July. We were blessed with a great week of camp ministry and good weather. Chapel times are held morning and evening outside, my favorite place. There was great participation from campers, several professions of faith, and renewed walks with Christ.

## Yakama Indian Reservation

In May, Tom Fox, (OAC Personnel/Development Director) and I headed over to the Yakama Indian Reservation to introduce the ministry and train some folks in the use of the sketch board. This is the fruit of prayer and time spent at the Indian Bible College (IBC) in Flagstaff a couple of years ago. One of the students from IBC is back on the Yakama reservation and now serves through Sacred Road Ministries, (sacredroadministries.org). What a great connection the Lord has put together, as Sacred Road is beginning to work with the Nez Perce tribe, which is just down the road from me. My hope is for future work with local Nez Perce members, as well as a trip or two back over to the Yakama Reservation.

Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people. Revelation 14:6
