The President's Gavel



International Conference: For nine days in May, I was in Ecuador for our international conference. It was a great & busy time with ~80 OAC staff from 21 of the 27 nations where we have official branches. The time there included the conference, evangelism outreaches, site-seeing, & much travel; primarily by chartered buses. The cities we spent the most time in were Puyo & Riobamba. Most of the time we were at an elevation of ~9,000 feet! Our conference hotel was located very close to a tributary of the Amazon River. I even got to see leaf-cutter ants in action; before, I'd only saw them on nature shows--so cool!

The host team put us all to Kingdom work & it was a blessing to serve the Lord in that beautiful country. Our small team got to minister at an upper-class, Catholic school--our translator said simply being there was a miracle. The plan was that we would share two presentations; one with the younger students & one with the older. At the first, there were ~275 wonderful, enthusiastic kids, who took in every word we preached about our Lord & Savior. After that, the school's leader approached & thanked us for being there, but she stopped us from sharing with the other group! In total, we participated in 33 Gospel outreaches, reaching ~4,500 people!

You may have heard of the five American missionaries who were killed in Ecuador back in the 50's, including Jim Elliot & Nate Saint. Well, we had the privilege of hearing the grandson of one of the men who killed the missionaries testify that he & a portion of his tribe were now Christians & that they were sharing the Gospel!
