

testimonies of the adults and children that wanted to be baptized were very impressive! The excitement of the children was palpable even though the youngest

boy was too afraid to step into the cold water. May his love for Jesus lead him to this step of obedience in the future. First Allen baptized T., the dad who also participates in the 'servant-leadership training', who then helped baptize his children. When one of his daughters was asked what she liked most about Jesus, she answered: "How HE has changed my dad's life!" The Gospel is powerful to change hard hearts and reach a whole family, like in the days of the book of Acts!







On October 22nd I flew to the East Coast to visit Ephraim's and Rebekka's families. In Pennsylvania Ephraim took us to the field of the 'Ringing Rocks'. What an amazing feature of nature. Hitting

some of these rocks with a hammer, metallic sounds in different pitches can be heard. This gives a new dimension to Luke 19:40: ⁴⁰ But answering, **Yeshua** (Jesus) said, "I tell you that if these keep silent, the stones will shout out!" (TLV) What would the stones shout? The same message like the testimonies of these baptisms: "Blessed is the KING who



comes in the NAME of YHVH! Shalom in heaven and glory in the highest!" (Luke 19:38)

Other ministry: Besides the regular Shabbat ministries we celebrated the Biblical Fall Festivals that point to the return of our **KING**. I substituted at Sho-Rap for Bible studies and distributed the Tribal Life Newspaper that includes testimonies of tribal believers. Pray that Fort Washakie Jail will restart the Bible studies for the inmates and that a house church can be restarted in this area. In AWANA I have been asked to teach two groups back-to-back. Keep praying that **GOD** keeps giving me new ideas to illustrate the Bible, also to the younger children who do not know yet how to read.

I also enjoy the **Hebrew** classes, since the students are excited to learn. Pray that the details for the **Israel study tour** end of **April 2026** will work out. In case you would like to join, you will need to **Iet me know by the end of November!** The sooner I know the size of the group, the cheaper the tour will be. (Participants can join from anywhere in the world!)

Keep praying for the *Enduring Word Museum* that is booked to visit Fremont County in March 2026. I hope, that by the end of the year, I will have at least a couple of firm commitments of school districts. The Casper team is still looking for an acceptable venue. The museum prays for a new trailer to move the big Gutenberg Press safely. I have started a fundraising account for this project. Simply mark your donation *'EWM trailer'*. If we are faithful GOD will do great things!
