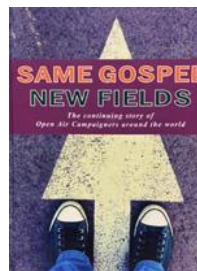

Bible Club Kick-off: As a result of sharing at the Calvary Curriculum conference, I was invited to help promote a new Released Time Education Bible club. As I was waiting for the kids, I met **Christian**, a 17-year-old young believer from Syria. He was at the school to reconnect with his elementary teachers. We discussed salvation, assurance, & sanctification. After the children were dismissed, one mom was upset about us giving out flyers, even though the school had already given us permission. Her daughter briefly spoke with me & believed that either everyone went to heaven or that reincarnation was true. She was a great example of the need for the Bible club.

Juvenile Hall Ministry: On Resurrection Sunday, I got to share again at Orange County Juvenile Hall & the Youth Guidance Center. The chaplain reported: *“Easter Sunday was a normal Sunday at Juvenile Hall and the Youth Guidance Center, but church attendance was good. Frank Baldus with Open Air Campaigners was my special guest and his paint-board presentation really kept the youth's attention.”* At one of the two presentations, I was led to mention how the Lord Jesus took the physical act of murder deeper, to the intent of the heart, from Matthew, chapter five. Afterward, the chaplain told me that one of the teens, who was in that meeting, was actually incarcerated for murder.



Tecate Trip: I recently partnered with a church on a weekend ministry trip to Mexico. The plan was for the team to build a house for a local family & for me to share the Gospel at a church. The Lord's hand was clearly upon the build & it was finished quicker than usual. After sharing, my translator sensed the Lord's help with conveying the message & a young team member shared that when the Gospel was presented, he teared up, remembering the Lord's love for him.
